**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ENFORCEMENT OF PREMARITAL AGREEMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46b-36g of the general statutes be amended to (1)
- 2 eliminate unconscionability at the time enforcement is sought as a
- 3 basis for nullifying a premarital agreement, and (2) provide that in any
- 4 proceeding to enforce a premarital agreement, the agreement shall be
- 5 presumed to be fair and reasonable if it does not violate the
- 6 requirements of said section 46b-36g and the parties specifically
- 7 acknowledge in the premarital agreement that the agreement is fair
- 8 and reasonable.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To eliminate unconscionability at the time enforcement is sought as a basis for nullifying a premarital agreement and to otherwise strengthen the enforceability of premarital agreements.
