**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ASSIGNMENT OF PROPERTY AND THE  
AWARD OF ALIMONY UPON ANNULMENT, DISSOLUTION OF  
MARRIAGE OR LEGAL SEPARATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That part III of chapter 815j of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 eliminate the requirement that the court consider the causes for an
- 3 annulment, dissolution of marriage or legal separation when making
- 4 an assignment of property or an award of alimony in such annulment,
- 5 dissolution or separation.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To eliminate the requirement that the court consider the causes for an annulment, dissolution of marriage or legal separation when making an assignment of property or an award of alimony.
