AN ACT AUTHORIZING MUNICIPALITIES TO PROHIBIT SEXUAL OFFENDERS FROM MUNICIPAL RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 98 of the general statutes be amended to allow a
- 2 municipality to enact an ordinance that prohibits any person convicted
- 3 of a sexual offense from being present at parks, playgrounds, sports
- 4 fields and other recreational facilities controlled by such municipality,
- 5 and to authorize such municipality to levy a fine of up to one thousand
- 6 dollars for any violation of such ordinance.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow municipalities to enact ordinances that prohibit sexual offenders from being present at recreational facilities controlled by the municipality.
