***AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR EXCEEDING THE SPEED  
LIMIT.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 248 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 any person operating a motor vehicle on a highway or road at a rate of
- 3 speed greater than seventy-five miles per hour shall be subject to a fine
- 4 of one thousand dollars and a mandatory thirty-day suspension of his
- 5 or her operator's license, with the exception of emergency vehicles.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To increase the penalties for motor vehicle operators who exceed the speed limit.
