**AN ACT IMPLEMENTING A RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHILD
POVERTY AND PREVENTION COUNCIL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10a-72f of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2007*):

3 (a) Within available appropriations, the Board of Trustees [for] of
4 the Community-Technical Colleges may establish up to three pilot
5 programs to provide for student household and family expenses of
6 students with dependents while such students are attending a
7 community-technical college. Participation in the pilot program shall
8 be limited to students (1) who are eligible for a federal Pell grant, or (2)
9 who are not eligible for a federal Pell grant due to a conviction of an
10 offense pursuant to 20 USC 1091(r), as amended from time to time, but
11 who would otherwise meet the eligibility requirements for a federal
12 Pell grant, including the income eligibility requirements.

13 (b) A community-technical college participating in a pilot program,
14 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall track the academic
15 progress and career development of the recipients and report such
16 information to the Board of Trustees of the Community-Technical
17 Colleges. Not later than January 1, 2008, the Board of Trustees of the
18 Community-Technical Colleges shall report, in accordance with section
19 11-4a, on the success of the pilot programs to the joint standing
