**AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SMALL TOWN
ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 4-66g of the general statutes, establishing the small
- 2 town economic assistance program, be amended to eliminate the
- 3 population restrictions on municipalities for eligibility for funds and
- 4 to make the towns of Fairfield, Glastonbury, Greenwich, Southington,
- 5 Trumbull and Wallingford permanently eligible for the program.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the towns of Fairfield, Glastonbury, Greenwich, Southington, Trumbull and Wallingford to remain in the STEAP program.
