**AN ACT CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN AID FOR VOCATIONAL-
AGRICULTURAL SCHOOLS AND A NEW FULL-TIME VOCATIONAL-
AGRICULTURE EDUCATION CONSULTANT IN THE DEPARTMENT
OF EDUCATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 10-65 of the general statutes be amended to provide for
2 an increase in the per pupil state aid to vocational-agricultural schools
3 to two thousand five hundred dollars and that the grant shall increase
4 by ten per cent annually on and after July 1, 2008, and that the sum of
5 one hundred fifty thousand dollars be appropriated to the Department
6 of Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
7 2008, and each fiscal year thereafter, for a full-time vocational-
8 agriculture education consultant at the department.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the per pupil state aid to vocational-agricultural schools.
