**AN ACT CLARIFYING THE VOTE OF PERSONS UTILIZING
ABSENTEE BALLOTS AND VOTING FOR CROSS-ENDORSED
CANDIDATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to clarify that if a person
- 2 utilizes an absentee ballot and votes for a candidate who is cross-
- 3 endorsed by more than one party on each of the party's lines, that such
- 4 vote counts as one vote and any such votes will be attributed to each
- 5 such political party on an alternating basis.

Statement of Purpose:

To carry out the voter's intent to vote for one candidate.
