AN ACT CONCERNING GASOLINE ZONE PRICING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any person
- 2 engaged in the business of furnishing gasoline to retail distributors of
- 3 gasoline in this state from using a pricing system under which the
- 4 wholesale price paid for gasoline by any such retail distributor is
- 5 determined based on the location of the retail distributor in any
- 6 geographic price zone in this state, as may be established by such
- 7 person and that no person shall discriminate in the price of gasoline
- 8 charged to retail distributors of gasoline in this state, except for the
- 9 costs of transportation and volume discounts.

Statement of Purpose:

To ban the practice of zone pricing of gasoline in the state of Connecticut.
