**AN ACT ADOPTING THE 2006 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE
LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM REVIEW AND INVESTIGATIONS
COMMITTEE CONCERNING ADULT LITERACY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Adopt a mission
- 2 statement that clarifies the purpose of adult literacy programs and
- 3 services in Connecticut; (2) develop a three-year strategic plan that
- 4 defines roles, identifies priorities and directs funding for an adult
- 5 literacy service system in Connecticut; and (3) establish an adult
- 6 literacy leadership board.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve the coordination and quality and increase the
opportunities and outcomes of adult literacy services in the state in
order to address current and future workplace development needs in
our economy.
