**AN ACT CONCERNING A TUITION FREEZE AND FULL FUNDING FOR
THE CONNECTICUT INDEPENDENT COLLEGE STUDENT GRANT
PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Board of Governors of Higher Education to freeze tuition at public
- 3 institutions of higher education at their current levels. It is further
- 4 proposed that funds be appropriated to the Department of Higher
- 5 Education to fully fund the Connecticut independent college student
- 6 grant program.

Statement of Purpose:

To make college more affordable to state residents and to fully fund
the CICS program.
