**AN ACT REQUIRING THE DNA TESTING OF PERSONS ARRESTED
FOR VIOLENT SEXUAL ASSAULT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That part Ila of chapter 961 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 require any person arrested for the commission of a felony involving a
- 3 violent sexual assault to submit to the taking of a blood or other
- 4 biological sample for DNA analysis.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit law enforcement to use the vital investigative tool of taking a DNA sample from persons arrested for sexual assault crimes and thereby assist law enforcement in solving crimes and preventing the commission of future crimes.
