AN ACT CONCERNING USE OF TOBACCO SETTLEMENT FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That twenty-five per cent of the annual receipts from the tobacco
- 2 settlement be dedicated to smoking cessation programs.

Statement of Purpose:

To dedicate one-quarter of the tobacco settlement funds to smoking cessation programs.
