**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO UPGRADE AND  
EXPAND THE STATE'S SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 five hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by
- 5 the Department of Public Safety for the purpose of upgrading and
- 6 expanding the state's sex offender registry system.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To bring the state's sex offender registry system into compliance with state law and to provide for the expansion of such system to encompass requirements of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act.
