AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR REGIONAL FIRE SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
4 thirty million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
5 Department of Public Safety for the purpose of a grant to Connecticut
6 regional fire training schools for implementation of the five-year
7 regional fire school improvement plan.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize bonds for improvement of regional fire schools to implement the five-year regional fire school improvement plan.
