**AN ACT CONCERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF
TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS FOR
CONNECTICUT'S ECONOMIC FUTURE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a balanced,
- 2 multi-modal state-wide transportation system, (2) authorize the
- 3 financing of priority projects outlined in the report "Connecticut's
- 4 Transportation Strategy", (3) establish stable, long-term financing for
- 5 state-wide and local infrastructure projects, maintenance and repairs,
- 6 (4) fund incentives for transit oriented development, and (5) increase
- 7 the Department of Transportation's funding to meet rising operating
- 8 costs and to hire the necessary staff to complete infrastructure
- 9 improvements in an efficient and timely manner.

Statement of Purpose:

To expeditiously implement the next phase of comprehensive transportation infrastructure improvements to strengthen the economy, reduce congestion, encourage public transit usage, foster

transit oriented development and responsible growth, and provide enhanced mobility for people and goods.
