AN ACT INCREASING FUNDS FOR THE TOWN AID PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 13a-175a of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the allocation of funds to the Department of Transportation for the
- 3 town aid program from twelve million five hundred thousand dollars
- 4 to seventy-five million dollars.
