**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF CLEANING PRODUCTS IN
STATE AND MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS AND SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) On or after October 1,
2 2007, no person shall use a cleaning product inside a building owned
3 by the state or a municipality, an elementary school building, as
4 defined in section 10-282 of the general statutes, or a secondary school
5 building, as defined in section 10-282 of the general statutes, unless
6 such cleaning product: (1) Is nontoxic, (2) has properties that minimize
7 the potential harmful impact on human health and the environment,
8 and (3) conforms to guidelines set forth by the United States
9 Environmental Protection Agency in its Final Guidance on
10 Environmentally Preferable Purchasing.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require all state and municipal buildings and elementary and secondary schools to use environmentally preferable cleaning products.
