**AN ACT PLACING A MORATORIUM ON CERTAIN ALTERNATIVE ON-SITE SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 22a-430 of the general statutes is amended by  
2 adding subsections (l) and (m) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (NEW) (l) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes or  
4 any regulation adopted under any provision of the general statutes  
5 and except as provided in subsection (m) of this section the  
6 commissioner, after the effective date of this section and until two  
7 years after the effective date of this section, shall not issue a permit for,  
8 nor accept any application for a permit for, nor allow the installation in  
9 any manner of an alternative on-site sewage treatment system with a  
10 capacity of greater than five thousand gallons per day.

11 (NEW) (m) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (l) of this  
12 section, the commissioner may accept application for and, within said  
13 commissioner's discretion, may issue a permit for and allow the  
14 installation of an alternative on-site sewage treatment system with a  
15 capacity of greater than five thousand gallons per day, if: (1) Such

16 treatment system addresses failures of an existing subsurface sewage  
17 disposal system, provided the proposed treatment system capacity  
18 does not exceed the capacity of the failed system; (2) such treatment  
19 system is necessary to remediate existing pollution associated with an  
20 individual septic system or systems; (3) such treatment system is  
21 necessary to remediate community pollution within a decentralized  
22 wastewater management district established by a municipality  
23 pursuant to section 7-247; or (4) such treatment system is necessary for  
24 the expansion of an existing municipal or public school project or for  
25 new construction of a municipal or public school project.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To place a one-year moratorium on the approval and installation of alternative on-site sewage treatment systems with a capacity greater than five thousand gallons per day.
