AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF HYDRAULIC LOADING OR UNLOADING EQUIPMENT AT CERTAIN SOLID WASTE FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) Each owner or operator
2 of a solid waste, recycling or resources recovery facility, as such terms
3 are defined in section 22a-207 of the general statutes, shall have,
4 during such times as solid waste is being moved with hydraulic
5 loading or unloading equipment, at least two employees of the facility
6 familiar with the operation of such equipment present in the work area
7 in which such equipment is being operated.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To protect employees of solid waste, recycling or resources recovery facilities from death or injury caused by hydraulic loading or unloading equipment.
