**AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY EFFICIENCY MEASURES IN THE
STATE BUILDING CODE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-256a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that the State Building Code be revised to require new home
- 3 construction of three thousand square feet or more to include an
- 4 electricity demand meter and to require all new home, condominium
- 5 and apartment construction to use compact fluorescent bulbs in most
- 6 applications.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce energy demand and global warming emissions by requiring certain energy efficiency measures in the State Building Code.
