**AN ACT CONCERNING FREE STATE FOREST AND PARK
ADMISSION FOR MEMBERS OF THE MILITARY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 23-26 of the general statutes be amended to allow free
- 2 admission to state parks and forests for all state residents holding a
- 3 valid military identification card, including retirees, current members
- 4 of the military and their legal dependants and that admission to
- 5 Dinosaur State Park and Trumbull State Park exhibit centers, tours of
- 6 Gillette Castle, admission fees for the Connecticut Valley Railroad,
- 7 including the Essex Steam Train and Riverboat and all camping or
- 8 special event fees requiring a separate admission be exempted from
- 9 such free admissions.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow military members, military retirees and their families free access to Connecticut's state parks and forests.
