AN ACT PRESERVING CONNECTICUT'S FARM LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two million five hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall
- 5 be used by the Department of Environmental Protection for the
- 6 purpose of providing lump sum bonding authority to the farmland
- 7 preservation program. Lump sum funding would be provided at six-
- 8 month intervals on each of the following dates: July 1, 2007, January 1,
- 9 2008, July 1, 2008, and January 1, 2009.

Statement of Purpose:

To preserve the environmental, health, commercial and aesthetic benefits of Connecticut's farm land.
