AN ACT CONCERNING RAILROAD CROSSINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 13b-291 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2007*):

3 When a private crossing has been removed by a railroad company
4 without the consent of the owner or owners, the company from whose
5 tracks such crossing has been removed shall restore the same in good
6 order upon the written request of the owner or owners, and, for failure
7 so to do, such company shall forfeit [five] one hundred dollars per day
8 to the person or persons owning or having a right to use such crossing,
9 such forfeiture to begin [thirty] forty days from the date of such notice.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
