AN ACT CONCERNING THE RETENTION OF BUSINESSES IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Economic and Community Development when offering incentives to
- 3 any business in the state to remain in the state to notify the chief
- 4 executive officer or the legislative body of the town in which the
- 5 business is currently located regarding any incentive offers. Said town
- 6 officials shall have no more than fourteen business days to provide a
- 7 counter offer to the business in question.

Statement of Purpose:

To give municipalities an opportunity to offer incentives to a company considering moving out of the municipality based on incentives offered by the Department of Economic and Community Development.
