**AN ACT CONCERNING INTERDISTRICT MAGNET SCHOOLS DURING
THEIR INITIAL THREE YEARS OF OPERATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-264l of the general statutes be amended to provide a
- 2 three-year grace period for interdistrict magnet schools for the first
- 3 three years of operation. During the grace period, any new school
- 4 shall not be subject to any funding sanctions or penalties due to
- 5 underenrollment.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect new interdistrict magnet schools from being penalized during the first three years of operation.
