**AN ACT CONCERNING AN APPROPRIATION FOR TRAINING FOR PARENTS OF SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS AND THE PROFESSIONALS WHO WORK WITH THEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       That the sum of one hundred thousand dollars be appropriated to  
2       the Department of Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal  
3       year ending June 30, 2008, to ensure implementation of the training  
4       requirements for parents and the technical assistance for school  
5       districts called for in the federal lawsuit P.J. v. State Board of  
6       Education.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide funding necessary to ensure that the Department of Education can meet the requirements for training and technical assistance called for in the settlement of the landmark federal lawsuit, P.J. v. State Board of Education.
