***AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING OF INTERDISTRICT MAGNET
SCHOOLS DURING THE FIRST THREE YEARS OF OPERATION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-264~~l~~ of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 decreasing deficit assistance for host school districts during the first
- 3 three years of operation of an interdistrict magnet school. Any host
- 4 district working in good faith to fill their interdistrict magnet school,
- 5 shall be reimbursed at the rate of seventy-five per cent for any deficit
- 6 incurred in the first year of magnet school operation; fifty per cent in
- 7 the second year of operation; twenty-five per cent in the third year of
- 8 operation. Deficit shall be defined as the difference between total
- 9 tuition revenues and school's operating budget.

Statement of Purpose:

To assist the financing of new interdistrict magnet schools during the first three years of operation.
