AN ACT CONCERNING INEFFICIENT INCANDESCENT LAMPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize the
2 Commissioner of Environmental Protection to study whether there are
3 energy efficient lamps available for consumers at competitive prices, to
4 create a list of inefficient incandescent lamps, to prohibit retailers and
5 wholesalers from selling inefficient incandescent lamps not less than
6 one hundred eighty days from the date of such lamps classification on
7 the list, to create a penalty of one hundred dollars for each sale of an
8 inefficient incandescent lamp on or after thirty days after written
9 warning by the commissioner of such violation, and to place a
10 surcharge of ten cents per incandescent lamp on the sale of
11 incandescent lamps.

To encourage the use of energy efficient lamps.
