AN ACT CONCERNING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STUDY REGARDING SEDIMENT REMOVAL FROM THE COLLINSVILLE IMPOUNDMENT ON THE CONNECTICUT RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars be appropriated
- 2 to the Department of Environmental Protection, from the General
- 3 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, to fund a study to be
- 4 completed not later than January 1, 2008, of the feasibility of removing
- 5 sediment from the Collinsville impoundment on the Farmington River
- 6 and that the study include a schedule and cost estimates for such
- 7 sediment removal.

Statement of Purpose:

To investigate the feasibility of improving the recreational, aesthetic and environmental quality of the Collinsville impoundment on the Farmington River by removing sediment from the impoundment.
