AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION CONSERVATION LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to increase the number of
- 2 Department of Environmental Protection conservation law
- 3 enforcement officers to a minimum of seventy-five to adequately
- 4 enforce current law.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the number of Department of Environmental Protection conservation law enforcement officers to reverse the current decrease in personnel numbers.
