AN ACT CONCERNING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each all-terrain
- 2 vehicle to be registered through the state; to increase the registration
- 3 fee for all-terrain vehicles; to create an all-terrain vehicle account,
- 4 within the General Fund, and to transfer all proceeds from the
- 5 registration of all-terrain vehicles into said account, and to require the
- 6 Department of Environmental Protection, with the proceeds from said
- 7 account, to purchase property for all terrain vehicle use.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the registration of all-terrain vehicles and to provide funding for the purchase of land for all-terrain vehicle use.
