***AN ACT CONCERNING AN EXEMPTION FOR ANTIQUES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 22a-623 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the written certification of a dealer of antiques that, to the best of
- 3 such dealer's knowledge, the product date of manufacture is prior to
- 4 January 1, 2004, is sufficient to qualify for the exemption under this
- 5 section.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To allow written certification from an antique dealer to be sufficient for the exemption for antiques containing mercury.
