AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND STATE EMPLOYEES WHO COMMIT FELONIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit public officials and
- 2 state employees who are found guilty of felonies from collecting their
- 3 retirement pensions and other benefits. Also any such official or
- 4 employee who is facing possible felony charges or under indictment
- 5 may not collect such benefits until cleared of all allegations or
- 6 indictments.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent public officials and employees from receiving public funds when they commit wrongdoing.
