**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY ON THE RECRUITMENT AND
TRAINING OF PHYSICAL SUPPORT ASSISTANTS AND
OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST ASSISTANTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Higher Education, in consultation with the Department
- 3 of Public Health, to conduct a study on ways to recruit and train
- 4 physical therapist assistants and occupational therapist assistants and
- 5 report back to the General Assembly by February 1, 2008.

To support physical therapist assistant and occupational therapist
assistant programs and promote the recruitment of candidates for such
programs.
