**AN ACT CONCERNING CREDIT IN THE STATE EMPLOYEES
RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR HAZARDOUS DUTY SERVICE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 5-192f of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2007*):

4 (d) "Hazardous duty member" means a member who is a state
5 policeman in the active service of the Division of State Police within
6 the Department of Public Safety, who is engaged in guard or
7 instructional duties at the Connecticut Correctional Institution,
8 Somers, the Connecticut Correctional Institution, Enfield-Medium, the
9 Carl Robinson Correctional Institution, Enfield, the John R. Manson
10 Youth Institution, Cheshire, the Connecticut Correctional Institution,
11 Niantic, the Connecticut Correctional Center, Cheshire or the
12 community correctional centers, who is an employee of the Whiting
13 Forensic Division or its predecessor institutions with direct and
14 substantial patient contact, who is a detective, chief inspector or
15 inspector in the Division of Criminal Justice or chief detective, who is
16 employed as a correctional counselor, correctional counselor

17 supervisor, parole officer or parole supervisor or in a comparable job
18 classification by the Board of Pardons and Paroles, who is the Chief
19 State's Attorney, the Chief Public Defender, the Deputy Chief State's
20 Attorney, the Deputy Chief Public Defender, a state's attorney,
21 assistant state's attorney or deputy assistant state's attorney, a public
22 defender, assistant public defender or deputy assistant public
23 defender, a chief inspector or inspector appointed under section 51-286
24 or any other staff member or employee of the Division of Criminal
25 Justice or of the Division of Public Defender Services who is a support
26 enforcement officer of the Judicial Department or who has been
27 designated as a hazardous duty member pursuant to the terms of a
28 collective bargaining agreement.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2007	5-192f(d)

Statement of Purpose:

To allow investigators for the Division of Public Defender Services to receive hazardous duty service credit in the state employees retirement system.
