**AN ACT CONCERNING DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS FOR  
MINIMUM BENEFIT HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700c of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 health insurers that deliver, issue for delivery or renew minimum
- 3 benefit health insurance plans in this state to disclose to prospective
- 4 purchasers of such plans information as to coverage under such plans
- 5 and a summary of the benefits offered under such plans which shall
- 6 include any limits on such benefits.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To ensure that consumers who purchase or enroll in minimum benefit health insurance plans know what they are purchasing and understand the limits of the benefits made available to them.
