AN ACT ESTABLISHING UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE INSURANCE IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish universal health
- 2 care insurance in this state in accordance with the following principles
- 3 to guide reform enumerated by the Institute of Medicine:
- 4 (1) Health care coverage should be universal;
- 5 (2) Health care coverage should be continuous;
- 6 (3) Health care coverage should be affordable to individuals and
- 7 families;
- 8 (4) The health insurance strategy should be affordable and
- 9 sustainable for society; and
- 10 (5) Health care coverage should enhance health and well-being by
- 11 promoting access to high-quality care that is effective, efficient, safe,
- 12 timely, patient-centered and equitable.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish universal health care insurance in Connecticut in accordance with the five principles to guide reform set forth by the Institute of Medicine.
