AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM CARE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 38a-501 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any insurance company, fraternal benefit society, hospital service
- 3 corporation, medical service corporation or health care center selling
- 4 long-term care policies in the state of Connecticut shall notify all
- 5 insureds under a long-term care policy of the company, society,
- 6 corporation or center's intent to discontinue new sales of such long-
- 7 term care policy no less than sixty days prior to discontinuing such
- 8 sales.

Statement of Purpose:

To require an insurance company, fraternal benefit society, hospital service corporation, medical service corporation or health care center selling long-term care policies in the state of Connecticut to notify all insureds under a long-term care policy of the company, society, corporation or center's intent to discontinue new sales of such long-term care policy no less than sixty days prior to discontinuing such sales.
