AN ACT ESTABLISHING A LYME DISEASE TASK FORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to study and make
- 2 recommendations about a state-wide plan for controlling Lyme
- 3 disease. The study shall include, but not be limited to, coordination of
- 4 planning between the Departments of Public Health and
- 5 Environmental Protection, strategies for prevention, public awareness
- 6 and education and best practices for reporting and classifying positive
- 7 test results.
