AN ACT CONCERNING AUDIO-VISUAL RECORDING OF A STOP FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-227a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that, when a person is stopped in an investigation of driving under the
- 3 influence, an audio-visual recording be made of the questioning of the
- 4 person and the performance of a breath test.

Statement of Purpose:

To have more accurate information regarding stops for driving under the influence.
