AN ACT PROVIDING FUNDS FOR TOURISM DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to segregate two per cent of
- 2 the hotel sales tax. Such segregated funds shall be allocated to tourism
- 3 districts established under section 32-302 of the general statutes for
- 4 tourism-related activities and promotion.

Statement of Purpose:

To dedicate two per cent of the sales tax collected from hotels to the state's tourism districts.
