AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR GLASTONBURY HIGH SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 seven hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be
- 5 used by the Department of Education for improvements to the high
- 6 school football and track field.

Statement of Purpose:

To assist the town of Glastonbury in this critical capital improvement project and create a state of the art facility available for use by the town, its students and for regional and state-wide events.
