**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ELIGIBILITY AGE FOR FULL DAY
KINDERGARTEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to allow local and
- 2 regional boards of education to raise the eligibility age for full-day
- 3 kindergarten to five years of age.

Statement of Purpose:

To give towns the option to limit full-day kindergarten eligibility based on child development standards.
