AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE EDUCATION OF CHILDREN OF MILITARY PERSONNEL IN THE TOWN OF GROTON AND OTHER COMMUNITIES WITH A HIGH PERCENTAGE OF MILITARY DEPENDENT STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the sum of ____ dollars be appropriated to the Department of
2 Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
3 2008, to reimburse the town of Groton for the difference between other
4 state education aid together with federal impact aid received for
5 education of military dependents and the actual cost of educating such
6 students, and that the sum of ____ dollars be appropriated to the
7 Department of Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
8 ending June 30, 2008, to reimburse other communities with a high
9 percentage of military dependent students.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a demonstrable investment in the continued viability of submarine base New London; to assist in providing a quality education to children of military personnel in the town of Groton and other communities with a high percentage of military dependent students; and to ensure that the town of Groton remains a desirable and attractive place for military families to live, learn and work.
