**AN ACT PROVIDING A TAX CREDIT TO INDIVIDUALS WHO
PURCHASE LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 any individual who purchases long-term care insurance shall be
- 3 entitled to an annual credit in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars
- 4 in determining the amount of his or her tax liability for purposes of the
- 5 income tax.

To encourage individuals to purchase long-term care insurance.
