AN ACT CONCERNING A SALES TAX-FREE WEEK IN DECEMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-407e of the general statutes be amended to include,
- 2 in addition to a week in August, from December eighteenth through
- 3 December twenty-fourth as a period of time when the sales tax on sales
- 4 of clothing or footwear of less than three hundred dollars is
- 5 suspended.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for a week in December in which the sales tax is not applied to clothing or footwear costing less than three hundred dollars.
