**AN ACT RESTRICTING THE USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS
IN CONSUMER TRANSACTIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to restrict the use of social
- 2 security numbers in consumer transactions with companies and
- 3 vendors and to establish stricter standards under which Social Security
- 4 numbers may be requested and used by such companies and vendors.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers against identify theft.
