**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ELECTRONIC RECORDING OF
PROBATE COURT HEARINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 51-72 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 each probate court hearing be recorded electronically by a competent
- 3 person, at the expense of the party requesting the hearing, if all parties
- 4 agree that the electronic recording is the official record of the hearing.
