**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner  
2 of Motor Vehicles to issue a separate registration for all-terrain vehicles  
3 that are used for farm or forestry work; to impose a fine of one  
4 hundred dollars for a violation of operation of an all-terrain vehicle  
5 without such registration; to create a registration fee of seventy-five  
6 dollars for certain all-terrain vehicles; to establish an all-terrain vehicle  
7 account within the Conservation Fund, into which the proceeds from  
8 the registration fee shall be deposited; and to authorize the issuance of  
9 bonds of the state for the purchase of property to be used as all-terrain  
10 vehicle areas.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To create new registration requirements for all-terrain vehicles, to establish an all-terrain vehicle account, and to authorize bonds for the purchase of property for all-terrain vehicle use.
